If you are coming by car, please car share as much as you can and unless you have disabled passengers please park as far as you can from the Stadium and walk in. We have limited on-site parking and do not want the streets close to the Stadium inundated. The two car parks and the drop off area indicated on the map are for cars with disabled people only. From the car park at William Harding Combined School it is a 5-10 minute walk through the railway underpass to the Stadium. Public transport is by bus from Aylesbury town centre bus station to the hospital A&E entrance, and from there it is a 10-15 minute walk marked by a dotted line on the map.

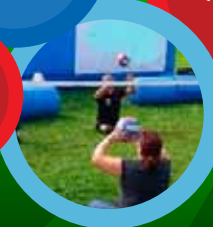
